
About the World Employment Confederation

World Employment Conference 2020: Rules and Regulations Governing the Sponsorship and Exhibition

Any matters not specifically covered by the following rules shall be subject solely to the decision of the organiser. These rules may be amended at any time by the organiser and all amendments so made shall be binding on exhibitors and sponsors equally with the foregoing rules and regulations.

Assignment of sponsorship items and exhibition space

Exhibit space and hospitality suites will be assigned depending on the total contribution to the conference and on a "first come – first served" basis. In order to make your reservation definite, the exhibit space assigned will have to be confirmed in writing within seven days using the "Contract for Exhibit Space" (will be sent at a later date).

Orders for technical installations and exhibition services are only accepted when confirmed in writing.

The final allocation of sponsoring items will be made by the Organising Committee.

The Administrative Secretariat will then conclude a sponsorship contract with the company.

The contract must be countersigned and returned within two weeks from the day of proposal in order to be valid for the conference. This contract is legally binding under Belgian law.

Conditions of payment

Exhibition & Sponsoring Conditions of payment mentioned on the invoice / confirmation are valid. In any case payment has to be made before opening of the conference; if not, the participation cannot be guaranteed and the fee remains due.

Cancellation

For sponsoring packages and exhibition space: in case of written cancellation by 1 October 2019, 50% of the contracted amount is due. In case of written cancellation after 1 October 2019, the full amount is due.

Force majeure

If the congress and/or the exhibition has to be cancelled or changed due to unforeseen events or general "force majeur", the organiser cannot be claimed for any compensation.

Damages, safety and insurance

Exhibitors are entirely liable for damages to third parties' stands, properties, health (be injury or death). To this extent Laurea Group byba and the venue are to be considered third parties. Exhibitors' liabilities are extended to their personnel and / or other people working under their control. Since neither WEC, Laurea Group and its staff or subcontractors nor the conference venue are liable for any damages and/or loss suffered by the exhibitors during the exhibition, including installation and dismantling – it is strongly recommended to arrange insurance accordingly.
