

Danish rehabilitation and treatment options


- Number of PwMS in DK has doubled since 1998
- Different treatment options
 - General practitioner
 - Neurologist (DMT, SyT)
 - Physiotherapist
 - Municipality services (care, helping aids, support)
 - MS Society (social worker, Psychologist)
 - MS Hospitals





MS Hospitals in Denmark

- Since 1959 and financed by the Danish health authorities
- PwMS is referred by GP or Neurologist
- Specialized MS rehabilitation
- 2 to 4 weeks inpatient stay
- Goal oriented and patient centred
- Group based or individualized
- Advanced MS is offered home visit and follow up
- 1300 patients/year 25%/3 years
