

Preventive and early support to parents

Children's health services responsible for

- health enhancing (increasing health factors)
- preventing poor mental health for childen 0-5 years (reducing risk factors)
 - →general activities
 - →indicated activities
- initiate action when children are at risk or has some developmental or health problem



Preventive and early support to parents

Social services responsible for

- children growing up under safe and healthy conditions
- promoting good and healthy developement for children in close collaboration with parents
- outreach programs and other preventive work to stop children from being at risk or in harm



Organization of common ground in Family centers

Family centers – health promoting, general, early preventive and supportive for parents and children


Steering group – managers representing the four legs of the Family center, together with the Family center coordinator

Setting joint goals for the collaborative work – based on identified needs, professional tasks and political priorities and goals, f ex

- Health
- Language

- All under the same roof


The purpose of a Family Centre

- To offer a arena and a passing/meeting place, for children, parents and families.
- To offer a place, where all the support that could be needed, are gathered in on place
- To offer a place where a child's best and interest, is in focus
- A family should always feel that they have come to the right place with their questions and that they can get easy access to the support needed




The Family Centre works preventively and with a child's health and best interest in focus by:

- To be available and offer a meetingplace for everybody
- To create trust and build up relations
- To strengthen the social net around a child and its parents
- To create ways of working, that involves children and parents
- To offer accessible support
- To be a arena for knowledge and a centre of information
- To provide and offer good service



What do we offer our visitors?

- A place where you can meet other parents and children
- A place where you are welcome, regardless of who you are
- A place where you have the expertise, out of different perspectives
- A place where its easy to "reach out", just by being surrounded by the different actors



What can the support look like?

Active Parenting course

A program and a course built up around how to build up the relationship with your child.

Involves helping your children to learn survival and life skills.

- A way to create a dialog and to find a natural way of preventing.

A Group of 5-8 parents meet up around every six weeks.
