The implementation of new SASO/GSO legislation which is the minimum level for diesel vehicles under API CH-4.

OEMs pushing emission control and fuel efficiency. Unlike in the past, the Middle East was not having a price hike in fuel, but now it has kept on increasing and coming very close to international prices which is forcing vehicle owners to use fuel efficient lubricants.

WITH INDUSTRY INFLUENCES AFFECTING THE MARKET on a global scale, what do you see being the specific impact of these on the gulf?

Currently the global trade war, recession in global economies and conflicts in the region.

WHO (PERSON OR COMPANY) DO YOU THINK WILL BE The 'Next big thing' within the middle eastern base oils or lubricants sector? And why?

ADNOC will be a major supplier of Group III and Group III+.

Synthetic and low viscosity products in the region.
