

The Fair of European Innovators in Cultural Heritage is a key event of <u>2018 European Year of Cultural Heritage</u>. The event will spot the light on innovation and innovators, with the aim to invest in people 'who will make the change' and support a cultural heritage innovation ecosystem.

Participants will have the opportunity to join the 'Community of Innovators in Cultural Heritage' and its Platform, engaging with innovation providers, users and investors.

The event seeks to respond to essential questions:

- Who are the innovators and 'change-makers' in the cultural heritage domain?
- What do they need to work better?
- How to promote an open innovation ecosystem in cultural heritage?
- Where is innovation produced?

These questions will be discussed with researchers, innovation providers, policy makers, representatives from cultural institutions, start-ups and incubators, business companies, creatives, pioneers from technology and economics, European Institutions representatives, UN agencies.

The event will build on the results of the <u>'Heritage and Innovation'</u> conference and will contribute to the next steps for the EU Action Plan on Cultural Heritage.
