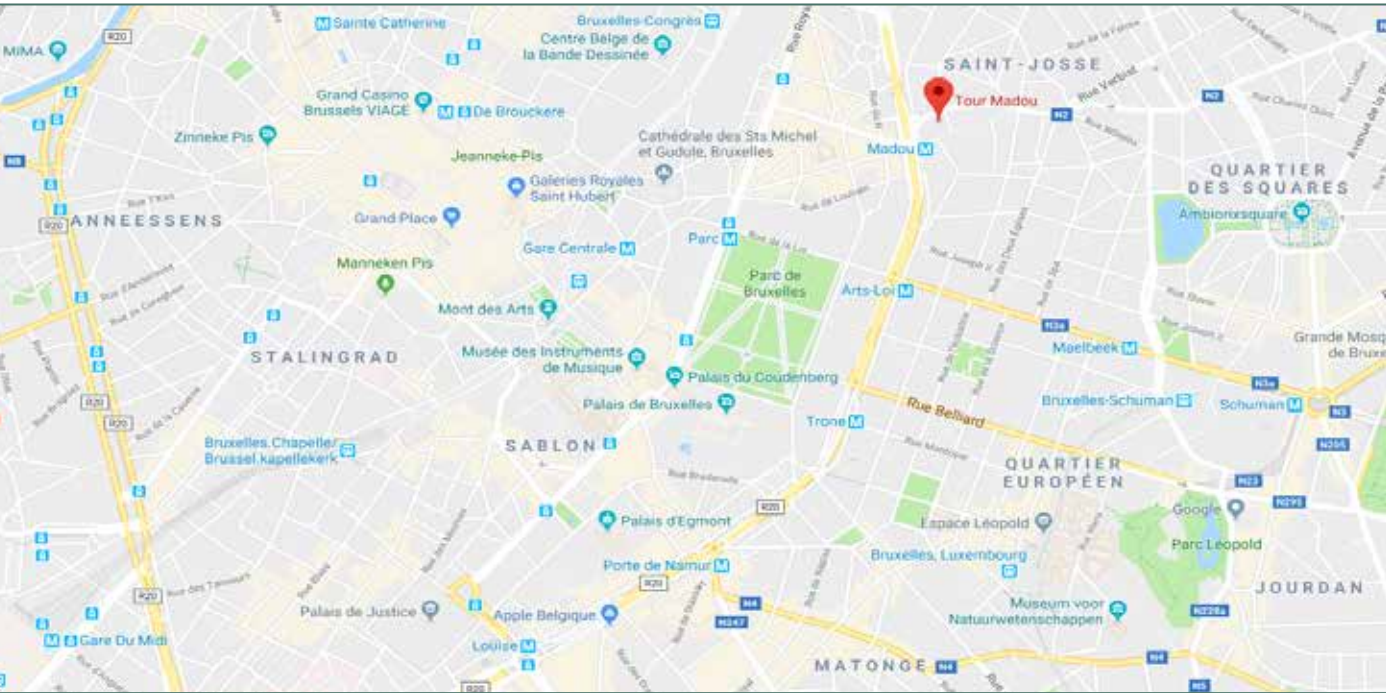

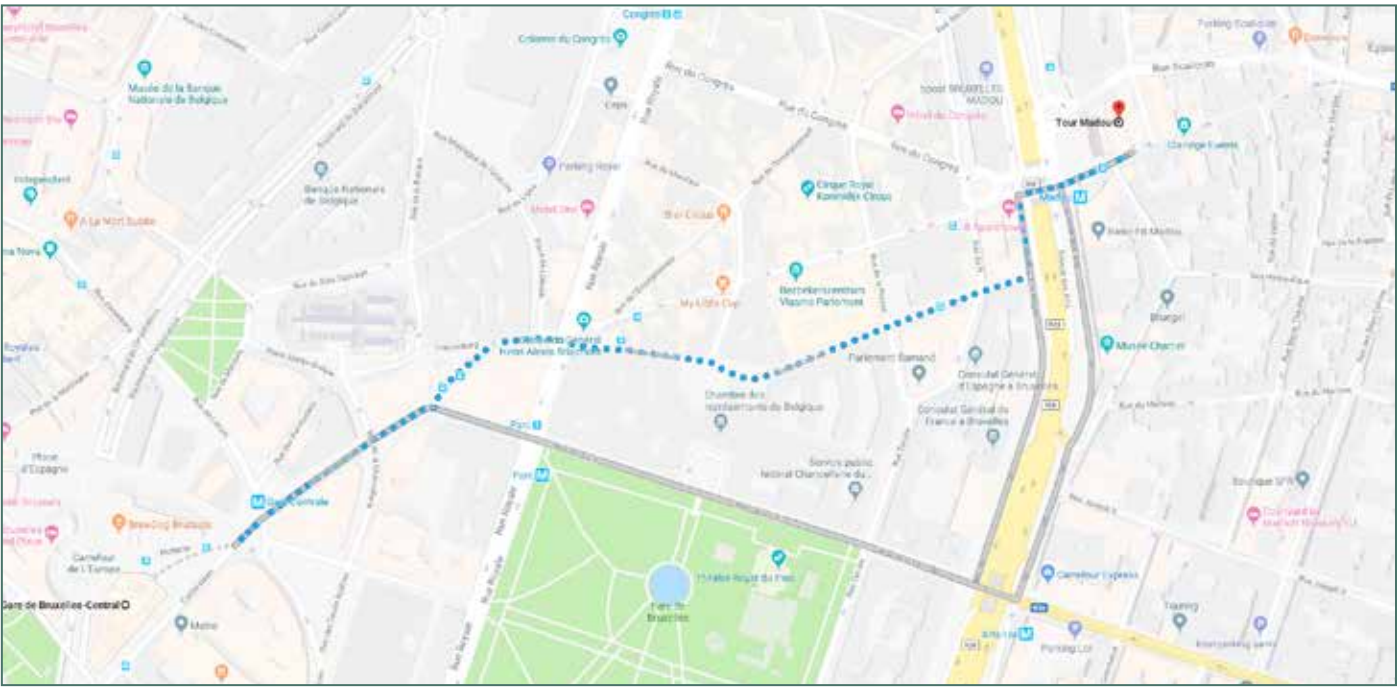
CONFERENCE VENUE

Madou square 1 | B-1000 Brussels | BELGIUM



From Bruxelles Central train station to Madou tower  
Around 15 minutes' walk



Public Transport

From "Bruxelles Central" train station to Madou – around 10 min  
Bus 29 (Direction 'Hof ten Berg') or 63 (Direction 'Cimetière de Bruxelles') – Stop: Madou (in front of the Madou tower)  
Or metro line 1 (direction 'Stockel') or 5 (direction 'Hermann Debroux') – Stop: Arts-Loi + 8 min's walk

From Bruxelles Midi train station – around 10 min  
Metro line 2 or 6 – Direction Elisabeth – Stop: Madou



How to get to Brussels city centre from Brussels Airport (Zaventem)

Around 20-25 minutes

Option 1: Take a train from the airport and stop at Bruxelles central (please note that only half of the trains from the airport go to Brussels city centre. The other ones go to various other cities)  
See above for bus and metro connections to go to Madou tower

Option 2: Take STIB - Airport Line to Brussels Schuman; then take metro line 1 or 5 to stop Arts-Loi, there change to line 2 or 6 to stop Madou

Coffee breaks and a networking lunch will be provided by the European Commission.

Please note that no shuttle service will be organised. Public transportation, taxi and parking will not be reimbursed by the European Commission.

The conference language will be English. No interpretation is foreseen.
