Technology and Future Cities Mission

Wanted: British technology companies to be part of a trade mission to the FutureTech Festival, an India-UK Tech Partnership initiative celebrating the India-UK story and a GREAT opportunity to connect and meet with Indian businesses.

India is now an established technology powerhouse and has been ranked the world's top exporter of information and communication technology in the Global Innovation Index, published by the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO), Cornell University and INSEAD. It is in 8th place for the number of science and engineering graduates, while the government aims to grow exports by 25% in the next five years.

By 2025, the global construction sector's output is expected to grow to \$15 trillion, with India being the third largest construction market, it was \$400 billion in 2015 and will grow to \$1 trillion by 2025 (KPMG). The construction sector is rapidly embracing BIM/Digital Construction as a catalytic agent for gaining operational efficiencies, with countries such as India also showing movement in this direction.

Through the partnership we will ramp up joint activity in AI/Data, Fintech, Future Mobility, Cyber Security and Healthcare AI, in addition to delivering an India-UK Tech hub and a range of state-regional cluster partnerships.

The missions to the FutureTech Festival will support this partnership in key sectors such as Agri-Tech, Creative, Healthcare, Life Sciences and Technology. The festival will attract the best and the brightest speakers, companies and entrepreneurs shaping the future and drive trade and investment initiatives.
