- Quality and consistency of customer service
- Detailed customer feedback and reviews (evidence of online feedback will be required*).
- Employee training and development.
- New ideas to enhance the customer experience.
- Online feedback may include: Facebook reviews, TripAdvisor, Yelp, Google, 888.org and other interactive methods (note: Don't worry, you are not expected to be on them all!)

BEST NEW BUSINESS

New businesses keep our economy dynamic and successful, improving its diversity, and stimulating competition with new ideas, new jobs and new skills for the future.

This award celebrates new businesses. Bexley needs business growth; by celebrating new businesses we are fostering a culture in which entrepreneurship is celebrated in our borough.

This award is only open to businesses who have been trading for less than 18 months.

- Clear rationale for starting the business and details of market research/experience undertaken, together with the story about what motivated the company's beginnings.
- Strong commercial performance and demonstration of how you have overcome any commercial challenges.
- Strong financial performance results since trading and to demonstrate any challenges you have overcome.
- An explanation of your vision for your business' future and an understanding of its growth potential.

OF THE YEAR

Entrepreneurs come from all backgrounds and launch businesses for a variety of reasons. They have many qualities in common, ranging from ambition, care, vision and tenacity to inspirational leadership, inventiveness and confidence.

This award celebrates an outstanding individual who, in addition to displaying those common entrepreneurial traits, can demonstrate all-round excellence. Please note this category is open to individuals only; if you are a successful partnership or team please enter the category for Best SME.

JUDGES WILL BE LOOKING FOR:

- Brilliant, inspiring, business leadership.
- Someone who stands out from the crowd an outstanding individual.
- Someone who has overcome barriers to success and obstacles to growth and shows grit and resilience.
- A great story about your entrepreneurial journey.

FOOD & BEVERAGE AWARD

This award celebrates the vital role the dynamic food and beverage industry plays in growing and sustaining our economy.

It recognises the industries influence in setting standards for food and drink, and customer service excellence. This award is open to cafes, pubs. restaurants, and food and drink outlets.

SMES make up a significant proportion of Bexley's commerce, and their success is a critical factor in our local and regional economy.

This award recognises the rich diversity of SMEs across all market sectors, and encourages their start up, growth and long-term sustainability.

This award is open to all companies with a current turnover of up to £10 million.

Business must have less than 50 employees and a turnover of less than £10 million to enter this category.

- A robust business model, with evidence of business sustainability.
- Innovation and market differentiation.
- Strong financial performance results, growth forecast and good governance, and a plan/vision for business growth.
- A commitment to business excellence and adapting to customer trends to future proof your business.

- Clearly outlined social goals and objectives.
- Evidence of community benefit and impact made in the borough.

A highly skilled workforce is the key to economic prosperity. Supporting residents into employment is vital for the economic and social fabric of the borough.

JUDGES WILL BE LOOKING FOR:

- Partnerships and collaboration, engaging with broader schemes to meet the borough's needs.
- Tangible support, including a range of activities such as school visits, mentoring, employability skills (CV writing, mock interviews), work experience and routes to employment.
- Evidence of engagement and impact, including diversity and inclusion.
- Businesses who can showcase the commercial benefits of their commitment e.g. through enhanced PR and Communications.

MADE OR ASSEMBLED IN BEXLEY

The Made or Assembled in Bexley category highlights the positive impact Bexley Businesses who manufacture or assemble are having on the local economy, and we want to showcase the innovation, quality and range of products made by local businesses.

TECH INNOVATION OF THE YEAR

- Reasons why the business has developed a programme within the community.
- Evidence that it makes a real difference in the community, either through working in partnership with a charity/social enterprise/school/youth club, evidence of a great Corporate Social Responsibility programme.
- Evidence that employees are engaged in the community either through volunteering and/or in-kind contributions.
- Evidence of the clear benefits and impact the business has had on the community (financial or in-kind, through time and/or resources).

BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

The 2019 Bexley Business of the Year Award, sponsored by Ocado, is the ultimate business accolade. It is awarded to the most outstanding business from all the 2019 category winners.

Companies are not able to enter the category directly, as the Business of the Year is chosen by the judges from the award category winners —this has been an incredibly difficult decision in previous years, as the standard of entries have been exceptionally high. The judges look for an inspirational company that can demonstrate all-round business competence, as well as one that can become a champion for Bexley and the Bexley Business Excellence Awards.

TOP TIPS!

How to create an award-winning entry:

1. BE PREPARED

Give the job of entering to someone who will 'own' the application process. Someone who will champion the value of entering to motivate the whole team to get involved.

2. TIMING IS EVERYTHING

Start your entry as soon as you can to maximise time to gather evidence and data you need to substantiate your entry. Factor in time to proof read and double check your facts.

3. WRITE LIKE A WINNER

You know your business is a cut above so write your entry like a good story that hones in on key evidence that will make the judges sit up and take notice.

4. KNOW YOUR BUSINESS

Add credibility to your entry by sharing pertinent financials, data and customer feedback but don't forget your most important asset – your people. Use them to show how brilliant you are.

5. KEEP IT SIMPLE

Less is sometimes more so avoid jargon and flowery language and double check grammar and spelling.
