  - exchange of expertise, producing and disseminating information, networking, developing and implementing projects

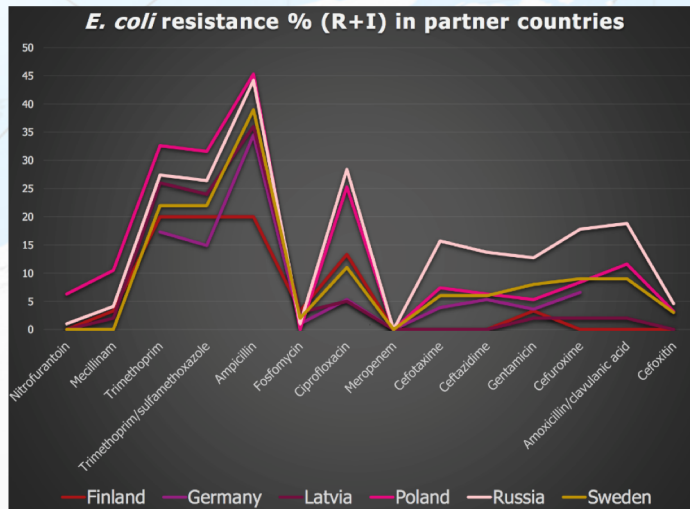
