



Eco-profile of high quality PP-recyclates from Systec Plastics Hörstel




*compared to virgin material




"From a single light to a "sea" of lights"

- > Plastics are being perceived as a "problem"
- > Think globally and act locally, initiatives needed
- > Market for recyclates remains underdeveloped
 - » Quality: Industry has developed successful light-house projects
 - » Pricing: sustainability benefits from lower carbon footprint of recyclates not reflected in price; scaling-up brings down the price

- Recycling targets are set against the licenced packaging higher targets will significantly increase the amount of plastics recycling in Germany
- > Licence fee modulation according to recyclability and recycled content
