Getting to the University

Unloading and Parking

Unloading

The exhibition will take place in the Parkinson Court, where delegates will also register and collect their lunch on Wednesday 4th and Thursday 5th September. This is also the venue for the poster presentations from Tuesdsay afternoon onwards.

Access to the Parkinson Building can be gained via the loading bay at the rear of the building which can be reached by coming to the main University entrance on Woodhouse Lane, turning right go through an archway, then turn right again. This leads to the rear entrance of the building. You will then be able to unload your items bringing them up in the lift, which is on the right, from the basement to the ground floor – please do not over load the lift. Parking is not permitted in the loading bay; please move your vehicle immediately after unloading.

Parking

Parking is bookable during registration at £7.00 per day. If you have booked car parking with us, please park in the Orange Zone Multi-Storey Car Park on campus (Post Code: LS2 3AA), accessible via Woodhouse Lane or Willow Terrace Road. The ANPR system will recognise the registration provided and you **DO NOT** need to enter any further details at the terminals. Please ask a member of staff if you require directions from the Parkinson building to the Multi-Storey Car Park.
