


product price + deposit







Deposit fee + industry fee per unit is paid




Return - package is returned, deposit paid back to consumer

WHY DEPOSIT SYSTEM?





- **80-98%** of material put to market is collected
- Highest material recovery, 100% reusable
- Packages with highest risk to city and nature environment are collected
- Also non- environmental friendly consumers contribute



- 40-60% material put to market is collected
- Mixed and spoiled materials are an issue
- Good for other packages material collection (paper, carton, plastics, etc)

DRSs view on plastics

- As plastic bottles coming from a DRS are clean, there is very high and ever growing demand for such packages
- Scarcity of qualitied PET bottles hinders the development of high end PET recycling (food gradable flake making, textile fiber making, etc)
