Proposed Motion 1

The Arab Regional Conference:

Proposes to explore having a Youth Forum prior to each Arab Regional Conference for at least two young women from each Member Organisation and allow them to participate in the conference.

Proposer: Kuwaiti Girl Guides Association

Voting Eligibility: Full and Associate Members

Majority required: Simple majority

Rationale:

- Providing young ladies with the opportunity to acquire new skills and benefit from experienced leaders attending the Regional Conference.
- Providing young ladies with the opportunity to experience what they have acquired and learned by participating in the Regional Conference.



Proposed Motion 2

The Arab Regional Conference:

Proposes to select two young women from each member organization to be trained remotely on governance, advocacy, and event management with the aim to transfer the acquired knowledge and skills to their organizations.

Proposer: Lebanese Federation of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts

Voting Eligibility: Full and Associate Members

Majority required: Simple majority

Rationale:

- Extending the reachability of trainings to reach a larger number of trainees who are able to transfer this knowledge.
- Enhance inclusion of young women across the region.



Proposed Motion 3

The Arab Regional Conference:

Proposes to study the possibility of establishing a world centre in the Arab region.

Proposer: Tunisian Scouts Organisation

Voting Eligibility: Full and Associate Members

Majority required: Simple majority

Rationale:

- A world centre would be an added value to the Arab region and would provide an increased exchange of skills and experiences between girl guides and girl guides in the Arab region and the other world regions.
- Providing a larger number of opportunities to empower girl guides and girl scouts in the Arab region.
