ICIS Innovation Awards Terms and Conditions of Entry

- The entrant's submission should refer to projects and work undertaken by the entrants from April 2019 - May 2020.
- Entries received after the deadline of 5PM on Friday 31 July 2020 will not be considered without the prior agreement of ICIS.
- Winners will receive: an award recognising their achievements in the chemicals industry, coverage in an ICIS Innovation Awards supplement and coverage in next year's awards package as previous winners.
- All shortlisted organisations may be asked to submit a photograph and or logo to be used in ICIS media coverage and should the event take place at the awards ceremony. Submission of such photograph and/or logo shall be deemed as a licence granted by You to us to use them in ICIS media and at relevant awards.
- Entry statements should be limited to 600 words.
- Supporting materials can be provided but should be limited to only highly relevant information of no more than 3 A4 pages. Including financial statements, testimonials, press cuttings and other published materials only where they add considerable weight to the entries.
- Any confidential information included to support your entry must be clearly marked as such.
- It is entrant's responsibility to ensure they have (written) permission and appropriate licences from any owner of the supporting material they are wishing to upload. This includes:
 - literary works such as articles, stories, journals, or computer programs
 - pictures and graphics
 - blueprints of architecture
 - plays and screenplays
 - audio-visual recordings such as movies
 - sound recordings
 - PowerPoint presentations
