



The Med Corridor: 6 countries – 6 borders












The Med Corridor: a closer focus on its Borderlands

Border Section: Figueres – Perpignan

- 2 Railway Lines:
 - Conventional Line Portbou-Cerbère (1875)
 - High-Speed Line (2013)
- Three main Urban areas (tot. > 500.000 inhab.)
- Low degree of cross-border commuting (2009) Lack of studies!

Important socioeconomic activity in the cross-border area in different sectors






Eastern French-Spanish Cross-border Connections Are Operational. But...

 Conventional Line: infrastructural interruption







High-Speed Line: 'Le Soler' Bottleneck










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

Med Corridor is an opportunity for main urban nodes and core logistic activities.

(Girona, Figueres, Perpignan, Narbonne, etc.)



Connectivity & interoperability improved

- Positive impact to small & medium logistic activities at the border
- Enhancing Territorial Capital for local socioeconomic development
- More efficient CBC in transport sector





Good news

- Legal: New framework agreement ADIF -SNCF Reseau (homologation rolling stock, emergency coordination in CB sections, etc.) to be signed.
- **CBC**: The Med Corridor is considered in the Pyrenean Strategy (2018-2024) developed by the Working Community of the Pyrenees (CTP)
- Planning: Catalan-Occitanie joint study to promote CB Fast Regional Trains (HSL)

Some ideas

- ✓ Joint Centralized Traffic Control Portbou-Cerbère (ECBM?)
- Studying the implementation of standard gauge in Figueres-Portbou section



Wider and coordinated train time schedule:

Via Perthus → High speed, IC/EC, Fast Regional trains.

Via CL → Special fare Figueres-Perpignan (ECBM?)

Reconversion of railway facilities: Joint training centre (EGTC?), Slow tourism, museums)












The Med Corridor: as a 'Framework'
