

CONTENT

Abstracts should include:

- brief introduction to the research question;
- aim(s) of the study;
- methods used, including statistical analysis methods;
- summary of results containing real data and the outcome of statistical analyses;
- conclusions and/or recommendations;
- Abstracts must report on high-quality original research in the field;
- No abbreviations or trade names are allowed in the title. However, the generic name may be used.

LAYOUT

- Abstracts must be submitted in English;
- The title should be concise and descriptive of the work to be reported. It should not exceed 20 words and must be written in CAPITAL letters;
- The author submitting the abstract should appear as the first-named author. The first author is expected to be also the presenter. List the authors names: Surname, First Name(s) of each author. With number(s) indicate the affiliation(s);
- Key words, up to five;
- Type the abstract text in Times New Roman, Font 12, single spacing;
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words. Title, list of the authors and keywords are not included;
- The presenting author is required to register for the meeting;
- Abbreviations should be placed in parentheses after the first time the word was used;
- It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific fact in the abstract text will be reproduced as typed by the author;
- All abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in the program book.
