Ljubljana Castle, standing on a hill above the city for about 900 years, is Ljubljana's main attraction. The castle's Outlook Tower and ramparts offer some of the most beautiful views of the city, while the castle houses a museum exhibition on Slovenian

history, a puppet museum, and several historical rooms such as the Chapel of St George, the Prison, and a video presentation room called Virtual Castle.

Ljubljana Castle, which can quickly be reached by funicular railway, also provides space for art exhibitions, houses a café, a nightclub, and two restaurants (Strelec and Gostilna na Gradu), and serves as a venue for cultural events, family entertainment, dance evenings, and open-air film screenings held under the title of Film under the Stars in the summer.

Slovenia/Ljubljana - social activities

Walking guided of the city

The local guide will take us on an exciting walk around the historical part of Ljubljana and pass some of the famous landmarks. You will be introduced to key historical moments as a town and the culture in general.

Hot Air Balloon sunrise tour

Skocjan Caves

The Škocjan Caves, carved out of limestone by an intermittent river, are listed as a natural UNESCO World Heritage Site. They are a spectacular underground world of gigantic dripstones, a subterranean river's rapids, and tiny little lakes.

Vintgar Gorge

The 1.6 km long Vintgar gorge carves its way through the vertical rocks of the Hom and Boršt hills and is graced by the Radovna with its waterfalls, pools and rapids. The educational trail leads you over wooden bridges and Žumr's galleries, and ends with a bridge overlooking the mighty 13 m high Šum waterfall.

The Vintgar gorge also includes two man-made sights. The single-arch stone bridge of the Bohinj railway, constructed in 1906, which crosses the gorge 33.5 m above the trail, and the dam from which the water is routed to the small Vintgar hydroelectric power plant under the Šum waterfall.
