Subject: 37<sup>th</sup> World Conference Circular 2: Registration, Nominations and Awards

#### 1. Registration

I am delighted to share with you the 37<sup>th</sup> World Conference Booking Pack, which includes all of the practical information you will need to arrange your trip. The World Board aims to support the participation of as many Member Organisations as possible and the Booking Pack includes information about how you can apply for a grant or for the special opportunity to become a member of the International Service Team. Applications for grants and the International Service Team are required by **31 January 2020**. Registration is open from 2 January until the **11 May 2020**. Please remember that accommodation is not included in the registration fee, to offer greater choice to participants. Do book early to secure your first choice.

#### 2. Nominations

The Nominations Pack and Form is enclosed with Circular 2, further to the Call for Nominations that was shared in Circular 1.

Please remember that the deadline for nominee applications is approaching on the **26** January 2020.

#### 3. Olave Award 2018-2020

The Olave Award is an international Award to honour the memory of the World Chief Guide, Lady Olave Baden-Powell, and to keep alive her belief in the spirit of service. It is awarded by WAGGGS at every World Conference to Girl Guide and Girl Scout groups that have created positive change in their community.

The theme for this triennium is "Be the Difference".

A panel of judges representing all five regions of WAGGGS will adjudicate and the winners will be announced at the 37<sup>th</sup> World Conference. We encourage all MOs to recognise the hard work that their members are doing in this area and submit a project for this special award.

#### 4. WAGGGS Medal of Service

The WAGGGS Medal of Service is the highest form of recognition that WAGGGS can bestow and it is presented to individuals (volunteers or staff) who have distinguished themselves in their outstanding service to Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting at both national and global levels. Nominations are made in confidence and the World Board will be responsible for the final decision.
