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WELCOME TO GRENADA

Grenada is a Caribbean country in the Western Hemisphere, situated between the Caribbean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean. Grenada consists of the island of Grenada itself, Carriacou, Petite Martinique, plus three smaller islands to the north of the main island.

Grenada is known as the Island of Spice, due to its production of nutmeg and mace crops, of which it is one of the world's largest exporters.

CAPITAL

St George's is the capital and largest city.

TIME 70NF

Grenada is in the Atlantic Standard Time Zone. one hour ahead of Eastern Standard Time and four hours behind Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

LANGUAGE

English is the official language of Grenada.

GRAND ANSE BEACH

Grenada has more than 40 different beaches: the most famous of them is the Grand Anse Beach.

A 3km (2 mile) long beach situated on the southwest coast where our Conference Venue is located.

Take great care at all times when swimming as currents can be deceptively strong and not all beaches have lifeguards and/or warning flags. You should monitor all beaches carefully and obey any local warnings.


CULTURAL CONNECTIONS EVENT

The Western Hemisphere Committee is delighted that the next Cultural Connections event will be held immediately prior to the Conference for young women aged 18 to 30 years old. This means that the young women participating in the pre-event, can opt to stay to join the main Conference to encourage greater participation of young women.

The Cultural Connections event will support young women who are passionate about our Movement to pursue a governance or leadership position within their Member Organisation or WAGGGS. It will also link to the current global project to deliver Motion 32 of the 36th World Conference - to look into the reasons why more young women are not standing for governance positions and to develop a set of actions that will significantly increase the number doing so.

RADISSON GRENADA BEACH RESORT




The Conference will be held at the five-star Radisson Grenada Beach Resort, situated in St George's, Grenada.

REGISTRATION

BOOK ONLINE THROUGH OUR WEBSITE!

Registration is now open for the 15th Western Hemisphere Regional Conference. Registrations can be completed online through the dedicated Conference website. This is the link to register <u>https://eu.eventscloud.com/wh-registration</u>.

Registration is available in both English and Spanish. You can book more than one ticket at once, but you will be required to provide the information details for all the attendees. You can edit your personal information and travel details after the registration is completed. For example, you can fill in the information about flights later, if you haven't already booked them.

For delegates and observers, the WAGGGS Events Team will review your application and confirm with your Member Organisation that you are part of the official delegation. You can speed up this process by providing a letter from your Member Organisation confirming this.

If you would like to join us as a guest outside of an official delegation, your registration will be confirmed by the Regional Committee.

Once your registration is confirmed, you will be sent a link to pay the registration fees online.

REGISTRATION FEES

The full Conference registration fee is US\$575 per person for the 15th Western Hemisphere Regional Conference.

Are you a young woman, aged under 30 on the first day of Conference? If so, the 15th Western Hemisphere Regional Conference has an attractive 30% discount to encourage your attendance. Use the code **THRIVE2019** to enable this discount, reducing your full Conference registration fee to US\$400.

Don't forget to register for the **Cultural Connections Event from 5 – 8 July 2019**. Information to register for this event will be coming in February 2019.

Interested in joining us for a day? We will offer day tickets for guests, and the registration for those will open in March. The day ticket cost will be US\$145.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Registration fees are non-refundable, even on failure of visa application. However, they can be transferred to another person until 17:00 (GMT) on 3 May 2019. Kindly note that any registration change can be made by logging into the website before the registrations close.

After 3 May 2019, substitution cannot be arranged and the registration fee will be forfeited. In case of unforeseeable circumstances, please contact WAGGGS by email <u>WH.ReCo@wagggs.org</u> immediately.

PARTICIPANTS

Each Full or Associate Member Organisation of WAGGGS in the Region is entitled to send two Delegates appointed from within its membership. The Delegates carry the authority of their Member Organisation to speak and vote on its behalf and are expected to participate in all proceedings.

In addition, Member Organisations may send Observers who act in support of their Delegates.

Where a Federation exists, the Component Associations of that Federation should decide together the composition of the delegation. Each Component Association may suggest up to two members to form part of the Federation's delegation. The Federation shall select two from among this number to be their official Delegates and any others may attend as Observers.

In supporting WAGGGS' mission of developing young women as decision makers, Member Organisations should make every effort possible to include one young woman (aged 18-30) in the delegation as either the conference delegate or observer. Young women who currently serve or are being developed as members of the national board, executive committee or sub-committees are ideal candidates to fulfil this role and will gain valuable international experience.

GRANTS

We hope to be able to support a number of Member Organisations financially who would otherwise be unable to attend the 15th Western Hemisphere Regional Conference. You can apply for the grant while registering for the Conference.

You can apply for a registration grant, travel grant, accommodation grant, or a combination of the three. Please click here to use our registration page and apply for grants.

The deadline to apply for the grant is 17:00 (GMT) 8 March 2019. All applicant Member Organisations will be informed of the outcome of their application by 22 March 2019.

Priority will be given to young women and Member Organisation delegations, who would otherwise not be represented.

The allocation of grants will also be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Member Organisation is not suspended and is up to date with membership fee payments i.e. has paid its 2018 membership fees.
- 2. Grants cannot be transferred to another person. In exceptional circumstances, a Member Organisation may apply for a change of beneficiary. This should be done at least two months before the start of the conference.
- 3. If the recipient of the grant does not attend the conference, the grant must be reimbursed in its entirety to WAGGGS.
- 4. Feedback on the experience will be required at or after the conference in a format which will be confirmed at a later date.

There is also an opportunity to sponsor another Member Organisation in sending their delegates to the Conference by making a contribution to the Western Hemisphere Friends Fund. 

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USEFUL INFORMATION BEFORE YOU BOOK

TRAVEL TO GRENADA

All participants are advised to book flights to arrive at Maurice Bishop International Airport (GND), Grenada by 16:00 on 8 July 2019. This is to enable participants who have to apply for a visa on arrival to have enough time, go through immigration, collect bags, travel to the hotel, register, check in and attend the Welcome Reception.

You will have to add your flight details during your registration. If you haven't booked your flight when you register, we will provide you a link where you'll be able to add the information later.

TRAVELLERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

Travellers with special needs, especially those with limited mobility, should note that disabled access is not widely available. Hilly terrain, narrow sidewalks, and accessibility on public transportation may present challenges. Please ensure you notify us of any such needs when registering so that we do our best to provide assistance.

Wheelchairs and assistance are available at Maurice Bishop International Airport (GND).

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

All participants arriving on Monday 8 July 2019 will be met on arrival at the Maurice Bishop International Airport (GND) by members from Girls Guides Association of Grenada. Arrangements will also be made for you for your departure on Saturday 13 July or Sunday 14 July 2019, for those booking a tour.

VISA INFORMATION

A valid passport (valid at least 6 months) and return or onward ticket is usually required for all visitors. However, proof of citizenship bearing a photograph is acceptable from British, Canadian and US citizens¹.

A visa is not required from citizens of the US, Canada, UK, British Commonwealth, most Caribbean countries, most European countries, South Korea, and Japan. Please refer to the government website for the complete lists of persons requiring visas and persons exempt from visas.

NB If you are travelling from a country with yellow fever, please ensure you are carrying proof of vaccination.

INSURANCE

Neither Girls Guides Association of Grenada or WAGGGS can take responsibility for any medical, accident, or personal property claims by participants of the Regional Conference (other than those that may fall under public liability). WAGGGS will also not be liable for travel costs in the event of cancellation of the Conference for any reason.

All participants must arrange their own insurance for travel, health, accident and personal property. Please also note that self-medication is the responsibility of the participant.

In the case of accidents or severe illness, participants will be taken to a hospital situated nearby. Please note that delegates who make use of this facility will be charged for medical consultations, treatment, and medication, and should ensure they have appropriate personal insurance.

LOCAL HEALTH CARE

While Grenada has very few creepy crawlies, mosquitoes can be a nuisance, as they can in any tropical country, and may carry viruses such as Dengue, Zika, and ChickV. These are not all prevalent in Grenada, but we feel it is wise to take steps to avoid being bitten. We suggest you take precautions by using repellent creams and sprays both day and night.

CURRENCY

Eastern Caribbean Dollar (EC\$) is the local currency.

WEATHER

Grenada enjoys a tropical climate, hot and humid all year round. Average temperatures range from 24°C / 75F to 30°C / 87F, tempered by the steady and cooling trade winds. The rainy season occurs between June to November, including hurricane season for the Caribbean. Grenada is located to the south of the hurricane belt and has a low probability of experiencing a severe storm, but do be prepared for a possible rainy day.

¹ As mandated by the United States Department of Homeland Security, all US travellers must provide a passport to enter or re-enter the US from both vacation and business travel.

CONTACT INFORMATION
