Invitation to launch event: Increasing productivity, competitiveness and resilience by tackling the interplay between obesity and diabetes June 24 15.00-18.00 European Parliament, Brussels

Dear Members of the Belgian Diabetes Forum,

We are writing to you as Member of the European Parliament and Coordinator for the Greens/EFA group in the SANT Committee and as Chair of the European Diabetes Forum (EUDF). EUDF brings together all key stakeholders in diabetes in Europe, so that we can stand united in achieving a common goal: improving outcomes for people with diabetes in Europe. We represent the interests of the 32 million people living with diabetes in Europe and their loved ones.

EUDF recently started a working group on the interplay between diabetes and obesity with disease experts, researchers, people with lived experience and industry. At this event we will present our recommendations and proposed solutions in the European Parliament to policymakers.

Diabetes and obesity are ongoing epidemics putting major stress on health systems and must be tackled urgently. If effective action is not taken, the number of people with diabetes in the EU is expected to rise from 32 million today to 55 million by 2050. By 2050, the prevalence of obesity is forecast to rise 32.9% in Central Europe and 46.6% in Western Europe.

Diabetes and obesity in the EU currently cost around 240 billion euros annually in healthcare spending and productivity losses. Most of these costs can be avoided through effective prevention and care. Investment in diabetes and obesity prevention, diagnosis and care can yield huge returns for healthcare systems and economies, all while saving lives and improving quality of life.
