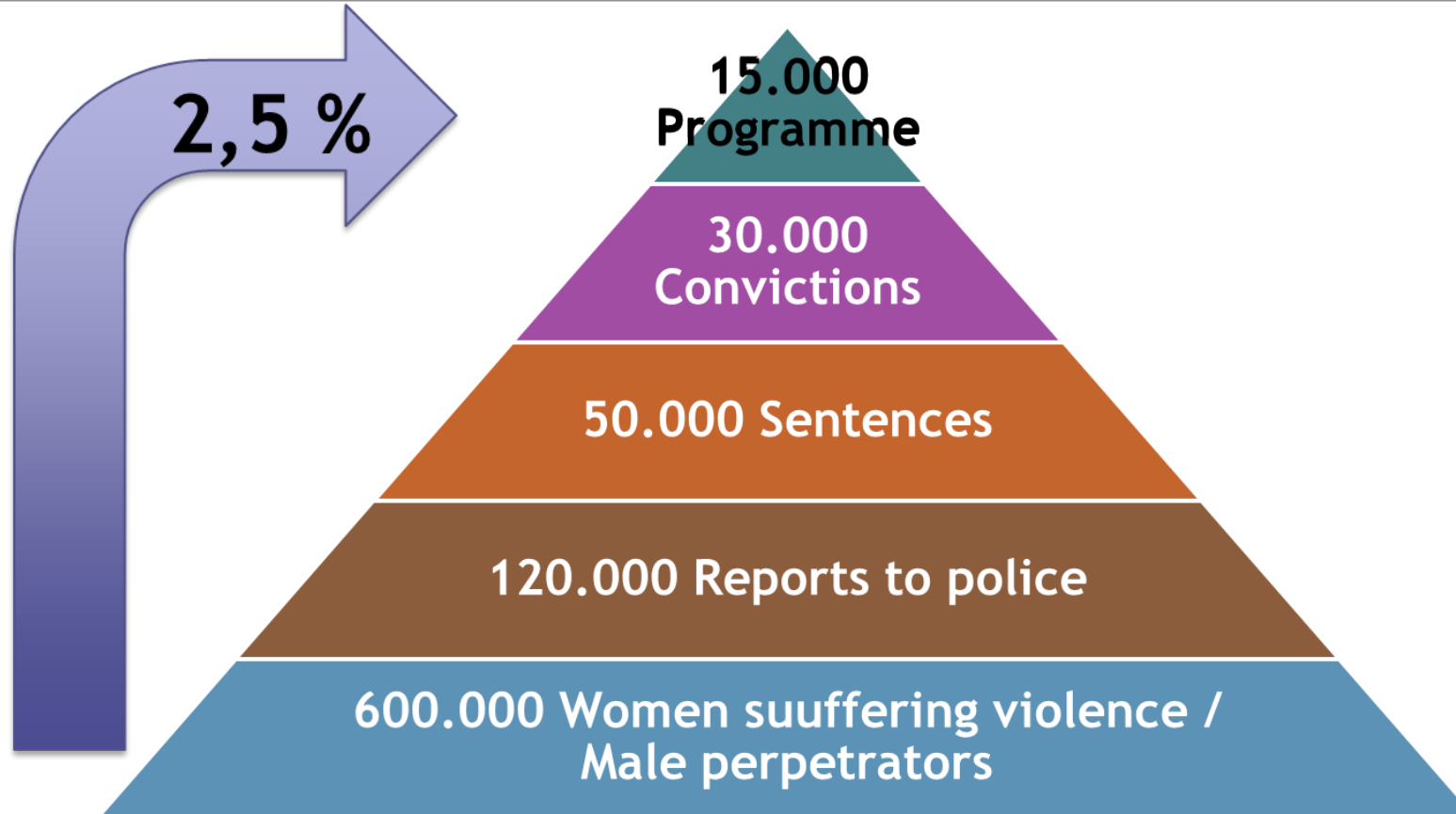

- **Low-threshold access routes**
  - Open structure, which invites to come
  - Self-reporting
  - Recommendation about other institutions
- **Networking, cooperation partners**
  - Youth welfare office
  - Victim support services
  - addiction counselling
  - psychotherapists
  - educational counselling
  - life counselling
  - immigration office
  - Family counselling

## OBJECTIVES:

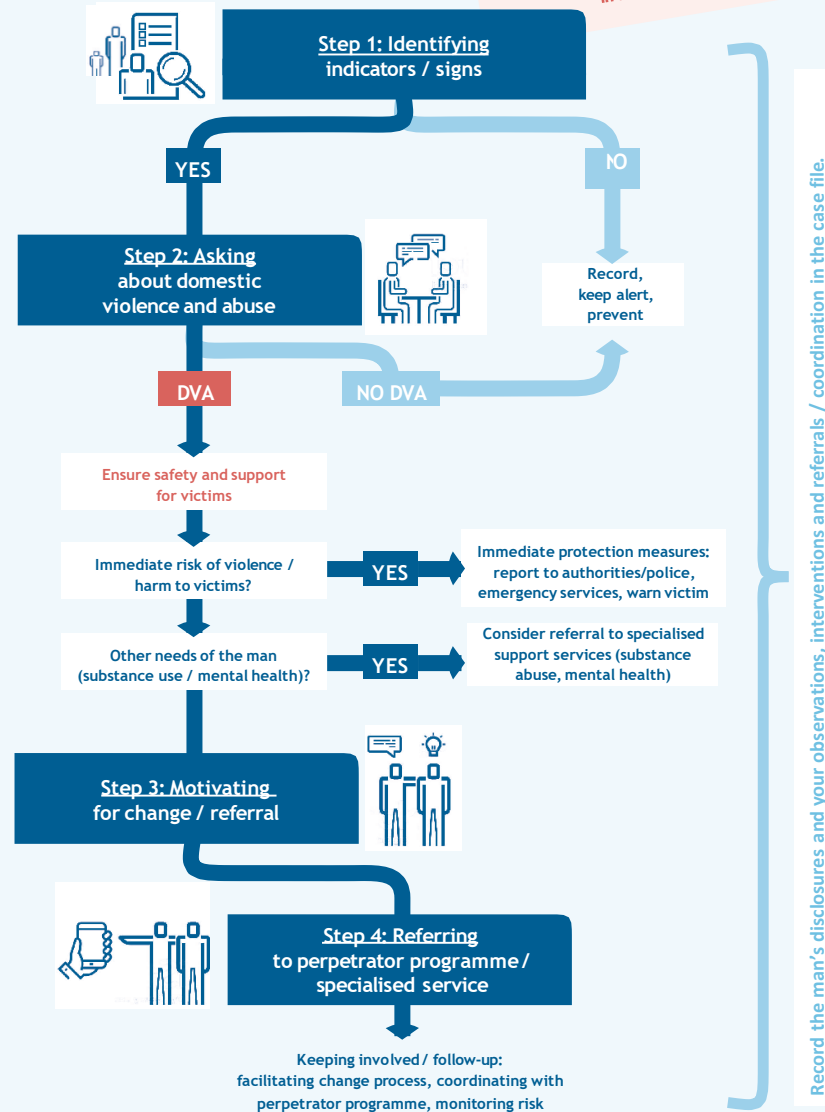
- build capacity of frontline professionals to address and refer perpetrators
